The Top 13 Questions

David, owner of Cruise Sydney Harbour answers your queries.

1. How did 'Bingo on the boat' start? Many years ago I called Bingo at several registered clubs and when I purchased the Funboat in 2006 I introduced Bingo as a trial on Sydney Harbour. I had instant success due to some very flattering publicity via Sydney Weekender and the Sun Herald as well as Ray Hadley, Ben Fordham and Susie Elelman from 2GB. Their wonderful support and endorsement which continues to this day, with many of their listeners calling 2GB's open line and praising Bingo on the Boat!

2. Where does the vessel leave from? We selected the Casino wharf in Pyrmont due to its convenient location near the Star Casino light rail as well as ample parking close by if coming by coach.

3. Can I get a discount? Our price is \$49 pp, this offers great value for a 3 1/2 hour cruise, morning tea, a hearty lunch, 5 games of Bingo and prizes. However, I recognise that is very hard for group organisers to coordinate a group especially when collecting money beforehand. To reward you, any group organiser who books and pays for 11 quests will receive 1 complimentary ticket for their hard work and effort. If you have a group of 24 then 2 of those tickets are complimentary and so on.

4. What if I don't have a group booking? That is fine, you can come by yourself or invite your friends. However, you will need to call our office or check our website for available dates. Once the cruise meets our minimum required numbers the cruise is guaranteed to proceed.

5. What if I don't play Bingo?

That is ok; you will still enjoy the morning tea, lunch and the scenery that changes every 5 minutes. We also play fun games such as, "name that tune" and have interesting commentary as part of our day out. If you don't wish to play Bingo you can go to another area of the boat and enjoy the cruise.

6. Can we pay on the day?

Unfortunately ALL tickets must be pre paid before the cruise departs as we have limited seats and catering is based upon this. My friendly office staff will give you several options of payment.

7. Does it cost to play Bingo and what are the prizes? No the Bingo is free as part of your booking and the prizes consist of small token goods, household items, chocolates, biscuits etc. As it is for fun.

8. Is the vessel wheelchair friendly? YES, please ensure you advise our office when booking if you have wheelchairs or walkers so we can arrange your seating to accommodate your needs. We also have a bathroom facilities on the same deck, they are not handicap toilets but are level.

9. How often do you cruise with Bingo? This depends on our group bookings, as stated earlier, we have a required minimum number to make it viable for our cruise to depart. As we are becoming more popular and especially with repeat business there are more dates to choose from.

10. Do you only do Bingo in summer? No way! In fact, don't be afraid to book your group in winter! Some of our best weather is in the colder months where the harbour is at its most picturesque and cosy. Don't let winter put you off booking! It is a fantastic time to experience the harbour.

11. What is on the menu?

When you board we have a 'hot cuppa' with biscuits waiting for you. We serve a hot lunch at approx. 12 noon, our catering staff are continually changing the menu but we quarantee that our food is fresh, plentiful and satisfying. Our reputation has been built on the 'value for money' that our cruise provides.

12. Payment Policy and options. Please appreciate that payment is required before the cruise date. As we have limited spaces available and we cater for you. When booking, you can make payment by credit card over the phone, send us a cheque or deposit directly into our bank account. If you are booking on behalf of a group, we require a 25% deposit at time of booking and full payment by no later than 2 weeks prior to the cruise. Group bookings - Groups will be charged for the final number of quest provided 2 weeks prior to the cruise.

13. Do you do any other type of cruises? YES, if your group would like to book a cruise other than Bingo we have a variety of other cruises please visit our website or contact our office for more information. We cater for all different occasions
